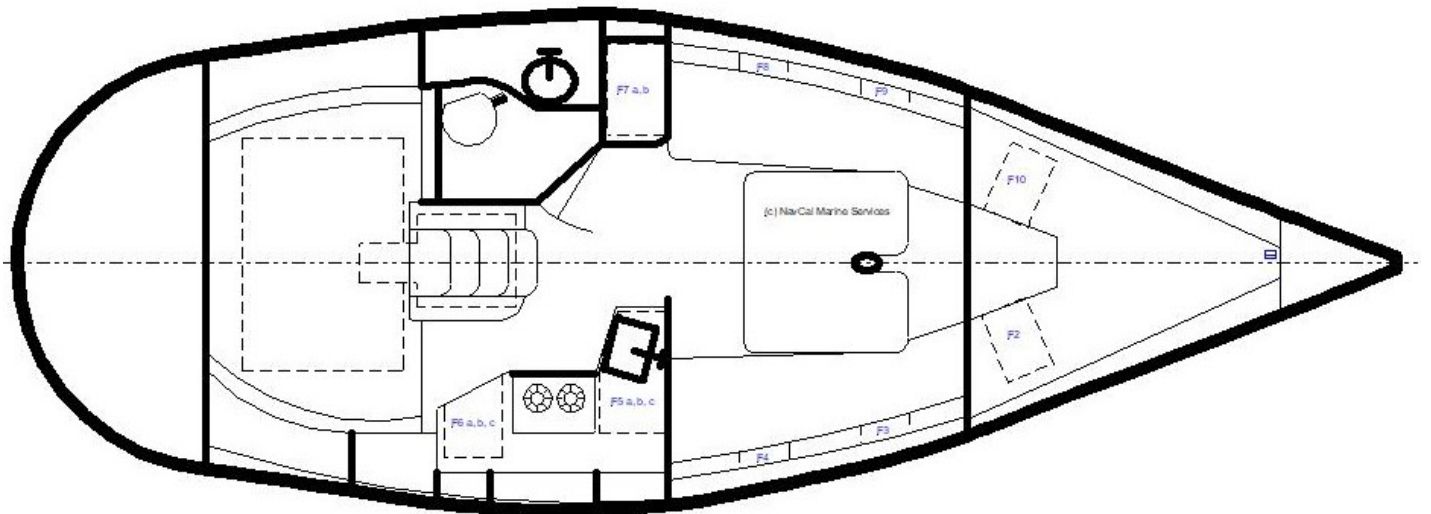
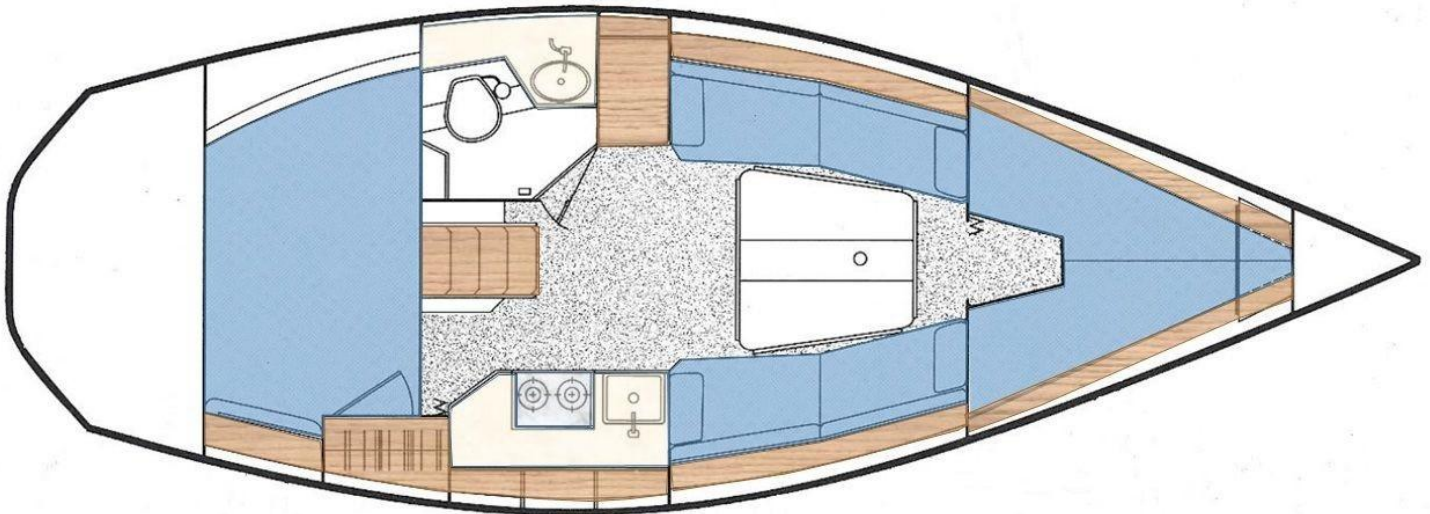

Documented vessel with name and hailing port on sugar scoop.

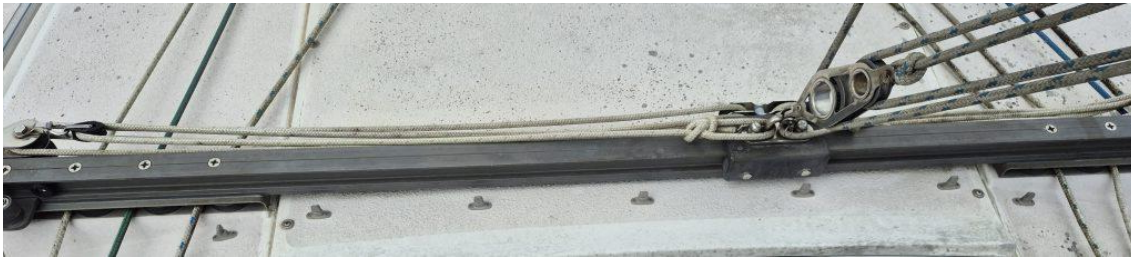

Plastic ventilation springs added under Vee birth and master stateroom. Vee birth has deck hatch with added wind scoop. Starter motor and raw water pump replaced.

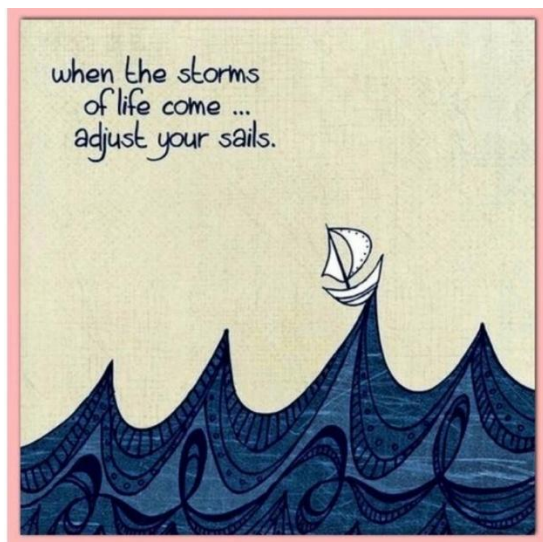
